## Student Qualifications for the Newaygo County Area Promise Zone Scholarship

- Residency: Student must graduate from a high school within the NC RESA service area or a Newaygo County registered homeschool program that meets the same requirements. Students MUST reside in the NC RESA service area (NC RESA's service area is not the Newaygo County Boundary, but rather school district boundaries.)
- Achieve a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.500 (Final, unweighted)
- Student must begin use of the scholarship funds within one year of their high school graduation and use all funds within 3 years from beginning the scholarship.
- ✓ The Promise Zone scholarship will cover tuition at the MCC rate.
- Student must apply to other scholarships for which you may be eligible, such as the Fremont Area Community Foundation and Gerber Foundation scholarships

## IF NOTIFIED THAT YOU ARE ELIGIBLE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING BY JUNE 30, 2017

- Provide proof of application for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year of eligibility.
- □ Acceptance letter and financial aid package from the College (MCC or Baker).
- □ Provide a list of other scholarships you have applied for and received.
- Homeschool students only parent needs to provide a high school transcript with parent signature at the bottom verifying that the grades are true and accurate.

## RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

For each year of eligibility, you must complete a renewal form, to be submitted by June 30, prior to the start of that academic year.
