HOW DOES A STUDENT QUALIFY?

Residency Requirement:

Student who graduates from a Newaygo County high school or Newaygo County homeschool and resides in the NC RESA service area.

Grade Point Average:

Student must have an unweighted minimum graduate grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Student enrolling in an approved apprenticeship program with local employment will be eligible, on a tiered system, with an unweighted grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

Level of Assistance Prorated:

100% if a student attends grades 7-12 in a qualifying school.

Use of Funds:

Within one year of high school graduation.

Time Frame for Completion:

Three years from beginning of scholarship.

The Last Dollar:

Student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and apply any other scholarship funds received. The Promise will fund the remaining scholarship value.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

Scholarship will cover tuition and fees for 62 credits at Muskegon Community College. Books are not included and are the responsibility of the student.

Student must be enrolled at full-time status to be eligible for the Promise Zone Scholarship.
