



## HOW DOES A STUDENT QUALIFY?

- Graduate from a Newaygo County high school or a registered Newaygo County homeschool and reside in the NC RESA service area.
  - Scholarship amount is awarded based on years attended, 100% is awarded if a student attends grades 7th–12th at a qualifying school.
- Achieve a minimum final and unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 (or a minimum GPA of 2.0 to qualify for an apprenticeship program).
- Begin using the scholarship within one year of high school graduation and complete the program within three years from beginning the scholarship.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and apply for other scholarships. The Promise Scholarship is a last dollar scholarship.

*Promise Scholarship applications are due March 1.*

The Promise Scholarship covers tuition and mandatory fees up to 62 attempted college credits at Muskegon Community College.

Books are *not* covered by the scholarship.

Students must be enrolled at full-time status and attend a mandatory orientation to qualify.

An online scholarship renewal is required each year of eligibility.
